1. Roll Call: All members present: Meeting was called to order by Chairperson John Schuster at 6:30 pm.
2. Approve the Public Safety Agenda: Motion by Kayla Muchka 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jane Fude to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 3-0.
3. Approve Minutes from June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023: Motion by John Schuster 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kayla Muchka to approve the June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023, minutes as presented. Motion carried 3-0.
4. Citizens Wishing to be Heard: None
5. Police Chief:
  - a. Monthly Report: June and July, 2023 Chief Beal handed out the monthly reports. Discuss and possible action regarding request from Clearview for road closure Car Show September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023, from 3:00pm-8:00pm Cty DF between N. Main St and County Service Road. Ed Somers present at the meeting to provide information about the car show.
  - b. Discuss and possible action regarding wage increase for Crossing Guards 2024. Motion by Jane Fude 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kayla Muchka to approve increasing the crossing guard wages to \$20.00 an hour, effective the start of 2023 school year being September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Motion carried 3-0.
  - c. Discuss and possible action regarding wage review Police Chief 2024. Motion to send to Personnel Committee a request to review Police Chief wages for 2024. Motion by Jane Fude 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kayla Muchka. Motion carried 3-0.
  - d. Information 9-11 Silent Parade 8:00 pm on Monday 9/11/2023. Information on the parade was provided to the committee dame route and meal plans as in the past. No changes.
6. EMS:

- c. Discuss and possible action regarding Stipend paid to Chief Curt Ninmann for mentoring.
