

Ordinance 263-2021

Ordinance to Amend Chapter 12.12.040 (A, B, C) City of Juneau Ordinances for Tree Trimming


The Common Council of the City of Juneau Ordains:

Section 12.12.040 (A, B, C) Tree Trimming is hereby amended to change:


- FROM:**
- (A) Trees standing on any private land adjacent to a public thoroughfare shall be trimmed and kept trimmed by the owner of such tree, so as to maintain a clear space of not less than ten feet above the sidewalk.
 - (B) City street trees shall be trimmed and kept by the city so as to maintain a clear space of not less than twelve (12) feet above the roadway, except that the Common Council may make special provisions in exceptional cases.
 - (C) No person shall authorize any city-controlled tree to be trimmed, cut or Topped without the permission of the Common Council and/or its authorized agent.
- TO:**
- (A) Trees standing on any private land adjacent to a public thoroughfare shall be trimmed and kept trimmed by the owner of such tree, so as to maintain a clear space of not less than ten feet above the sidewalk, **and fifteen (15) above the roadway.**
 - (B) City street trees shall be trimmed and kept by the city so as to maintain a clear space of not less than **fifteen (15)** feet above the roadway, except that the Common Council may make special provisions in exceptional cases.
 - (C) No person shall authorize any city-controlled tree to be trimmed, cut or Topped without the permission of the Common Council and/or **DPW Director.**
